## REMINDER ABOUT BUILDING PROTOCOLS

As a reminder, our buildings at Kensington Village remain on outbreak protocols. Residents are only allowed to leave their suites to do essential laundry, dispose of garbage, and go outside for a 15 minute walk. The courtyard still remains closed.

When leaving your suite, a mask must be worn properly at all times. The mask must cover your nose and go below your chin. For routine transactions like groceries, food, and medication, you are strongly advised to take advantage of delivery services or utilize friends and families as partners in care to help you.

If you do need to leave the building for essential appointments, please wear a mask at all times and isolate upon returning.

Please also continue to monitor yourself for any COVID-19 symptoms using the tracking tool provided to you last week.
