Re: COVID-19 Relaunch Strategy – Kensington Village Condominiums

When the pandemic began, Shepherd's Care Foundation took swift and decisive action to protect our residents and staff at all our facilities. Thanks to those actions, and to your help in abiding by the guidelines, we have successfully contained and eliminated the COVID-19 outbreak at the Kensington Village campus.

We have further confirmed with public health that the "Outbreak" status for independent residents at Kensington Village was lifted effective today, June 22, 2020. This includes the independent condos, bungalows, Manor, Inn, lodge, as well as the Designated Supportive Living units and dementia cottages. The "Outbreak" status on the long term care at Kensington Village is expected to remain for another few weeks. **Although the outbreak status has been lifted for your area, the orders from the Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) remain in effect.**

With the curve appearing to be flattened, and with our political and public health leadership signaling that now is the time to begin to relaunch our economy and prudently relax COVID-19 restrictions, we are announcing our relaunch strategy for the Kensington Village Condominiums.

Relaunch Strategy

Effective June 22, 2020, Shepherd's Care Foundation will no longer continue to enforce the Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) orders at the Kensington Village condominiums. As an independent building, it will be up to the individual residents and your condo association to ensure you have the safeguards in place to continue to protect against COVID-19.

This means we will not be doing the additional wellness phone calls and COVID -19 newsletters as we have been doing during the pandemic. We will return to monthly Mission Effectiveness newsletters including pastoral care and recreation calendars when it is safe to do so in the coming months.

Kensington Campus Site Restrictions

In order to ensure we prevent any further outbreak, **Kensington Village condo residents are not permitted to enter any other area of the campus for the duration of the pandemic or until determined otherwise by Shepherd's Care.** In particular, this means that both the hairdresser and the courtyard remain unavailable to condo residents. The Kensington Village restaurant also remains closed until further notice.

Kensington Condo Site Restrictions

The Condo Association will resume control over, and is responsible for, facility measures. This includes the visitation policy and the on-site amenities.

Safety and Security Measures

Although we will no longer be enforcing the orders, you are still required to follow the guidelines from the Chief Medical Officer of Health to keep yourself and your neighbours safe.

These guidelines include:

- Avoid having visitors in the building and in your suite;
- Practice good hand hygiene – wash your hands thoroughly and use alcohol-based hand sanitizer, especially when interacting with high-touch surfaces like your mailbox;
- Always wear your mask when you are not in your suite;
- Try to self-isolate as much as possible, including using delivery services;
- Continue to use the daily self-screening tool for COVID-19 symptoms;
- If you are feeling ill, do not leave your suite and call 811 immediately;
- Restrict gatherings to a number where you can practice social distancing (2 metres / 6 feet);
- Consider getting yourself tested for COVID-19 regularly – Alberta has opened up asymptomatic testing to all residents. To arrange this, call 811 or visit www.albertahealthservices.ca.
