It is with great sadness that I am writing to inform you of the passing of one of our long term care residents yesterday afternoon at Kensington Village with COVID-19. We received confirmation of the positive test only yesterday afternoon.

On behalf of Shepherd's Care Foundation, we extend our condolences to their families and friends, to their fellow residents at Kensington Village, and to our staff who have been tirelessly providing compassionate care to our residents.

We have already identified a fellow resident and two staff who have been placed on isolation as a precaution. We have directed long term care residents to remain in their rooms and have implemented tray meal service effective immediately.

Shepherd's Care and our dedicated outbreak physician are strongly advocating that all residents and staff at Kensington Village be tested for COVID-19 immediately. We continue to work with AHS to make this happen.

We continue to ensure we are doing everything in our power to protect our residents and staff from this terrible virus.

As we grieve collectively, let us take comfort in these words from John 16:22 *"So with you: Now is your time of grief, but I will see you again and you will rejoice, and no one will take away your joy."*
