COVID-19 UPDATE

As of today, we have not had a positive test in long term care since April 30, and in independent living since April 16. All 22 resident cases have been at Kensington Village. Of those, 11 have been deemed "Recovered", and 3 have sadly passed away. There have also been 10 staff cases at Kensington Village, 5 of which have "Recovered".
